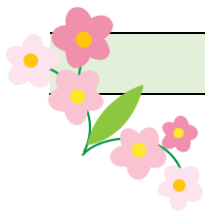

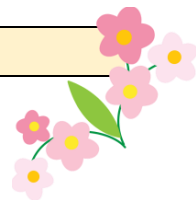

## Clearview Regional School District Named "Top Community for Music Education"

The Clearview Regional High School District was named to the 2026 National Association for Music Merchants (NAMM) Best

**Communities for Music Education (BCME)**. This marks the eighth year that the Clearview Regional High School District has received this prestigious honor, a mark of continued excellence within the music programs in the district. Now in its third decade, the **Best Communities for Music Education** designation is awarded to districts that demonstrate outstanding achievement in efforts to provide music access and education to all students. Inclusion on the BCME list acknowledges the Clearview Regional School District as one of the top six percent (6%) of school districts in the country for music education. School districts listed in the BCME list go through a vetting process organized by NAMM and leading experts in the music education field, looking at the curricular music offerings in the district, recent student and ensemble honors, number of students engaged in school music classes across all grade levels, extracurricular musical offerings, teacher qualifications, community engagement, district and administrative support, as well as other music events, and opportunities provided to students and teachers

in and out of district music classrooms. The Clearview Regional School District scored highly in all categories of the application based on a strong tradition of excellence in both curricular and extracurricular ensembles, opportunities for all students to be involved in both middle school and high school elective music classes, student participation in local and state honors ensembles, opportunities in emerging music education programs such as the Modern Band, and strong support from the community as well as school and district administrations. The Clearview Regional School District Music Department would like to thank Mr. John Horchak III and the district administrative team, as well as the administration and staff at both the high school and middle school for their continued support of music education in the school district.
