About the Clearview Regional H.S. Program

The Clearview Regional High School instrumental music program is a tiered system of ensembles seeking to facilitate the complete musical development of its students. The Wind Ensemble, Wind Symphony, Symphonic Band, Percussion Ensemble, and chamber ensembles meet during school hours as part of a balanced array of curricular musical offerings.

The instrumental music supports two-hundred and fifty students in grades 7 - 12. The program is comprised of five curricular ensembles, ranging from a grade level ensemble in middle school to the award-winning Honors Wind Ensemble. Students can participate in numerous extracurricular ensembles, including a marching band, colorguard, jazz band, and select chamber ensembles. Clearview students and ensembles perform throughout the Mullica Hill and Southern New Jersey area.

About the Honors Wind Ensemble

The Honors Wind Ensemble studies a large and diverse selection of wind musical repertoire; including cornerstone band literature, transcriptions from other musical mediums, works with feature artists, and popular music arrangements/transcriptions. The group performs between five and eight performances in a school year, including individual, chamber ensemble, and large ensemble works for diverse audiences including the extended Mullica Hill community as well as at regional and state festivals.

Over the past three years the ensemble received Superior ratings at the South Jersey Region Band Festival and has participated in both the New Jersey State Band Gala as well as the New Jersey Music Educators Association Conference. Members of the Wind Ensemble have received numerous individual accolades, including being named to All-South Jersey, All-State, and All-Eastern ensembles, as well as participation in local independent honors ensembles.
